



MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS STABILIZATION RESPITE ADMISSION CRITERIA

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Admission hours: 8:00am – 10:00pm
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Currently presenting in a mental health crisis
- Be assessed to have a mental health disorder, or suspected mental health disorder
- Agreeable to placement and voluntarily consent to treatment
- Medically stable; no acute medical conditions requiring inpatient hospitalization
- Must be ambulatory and able to evacuate within 3-minutes with minimal assistance
- Crisis is primarily the result of psychiatric symptoms linked to a mental health disorder
- Note: Individuals under civil commitment or other legal mandates allowable
 - Individuals under civil commitment require Trial Visit

EXCLUSIONARY CRITERIA

- Currently meeting criteria for mental health hold or under arrest
- Medical condition requiring secured, inpatient treatment
- Recent history of violent or person-to-person crimes or acts
- Current risk of withdrawal requiring medical monitoring
- Symptoms are primarily a result of other conditions, including but not limited to:
 - Intellectual/Development Disabilities
 - Neurocognitive Disorders (Dementia, Alzheimer's)
 - Substance Use Disorder only (e.g. symptoms only present while intoxicated)
 - Resistant to treatment (Personality Disorders)
- Crisis is primarily a result of non-psychiatric factors, to include:
 - Lack of housing/shelter options (Homelessness)
 - Antisocial conduct and criminal behavior
 - Impulsivity caused by other than mental health symptoms

SCREENING AND DETERMINATION

The Program Administrator or Designee will screen all referrals to ensure the individual meets the program and admission criteria. All referrals are accepted for review, regardless of payer or ability to pay.

REFERRAL PROCEDURE

1. Call for bed availability and admit screening: **(541)316-7530**
2. Complete Brooks Respite Referral – *completed by QMHP*
3. Obtain current medication list
4. Include background, supplemental, and/or legal documentation:
 - Crisis or Psychiatric Assessment
 - Lab results, UDS, BAL – *when in hospital*
 - Guardianship, Commitment, Trial Visit, Legal Restrictions, PSRB, etc., *if applicable*
5. Fax all paperwork to Brooks: **(541)797-5011**
6. Arrange transportation to Brooks (medical transport, taxi, family, provider, etc.)
 - Recommend point A to B. Do not allow client to go home and admit at leisure.

WRITTEN REFERRAL REQUIREMENTS: *(consistent with OAR 309-035-0163(5)(b))*

1. Written documentation that the prospective individual has a mental health disorder
2. Background information including a crisis or mental health assessment, summary of current mental health treatment involvement, behavioral issues, and risk factors
3. Legal documents (guardianship, commitment status, other restrictions) *when applicable*
4. Description of current crisis and need for crisis-respite placement
5. Prospective treatment and discharge plan
6. Expected length of placement to stabilize the psychiatric crisis *(targeted length of stay is typically 3-5 days)*
